The Alzheimer's Association is a national agency dedicated to conducting research for the prevention, cure and treatment of Alzheimer's disease and related disorders and to providing education, information and referral, support and assistance to individuals with Alzheimer's and their families.

There is a Connecticut chapter of the Association that trains and develops many local support groups to help the families of those with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders. Educational programs for families and professionals are conducted regularly.

The Chapter also participates in a program called Safe Return, in which participants receive 1-800 number I.D. bracelets that are used to return wanderers to their caregivers. The Association also provides education and outreach for the Statewide Respite Care Program.
