

Senior/Disabled Photo Reduced Fare Card

Description:

Senior citizens, age 65 and older, and persons of any age with a disability can travel for a reduced fare at any time on CTTRANSIT and all other bus systems operating under contract with the Connecticut Department of Transportation. Reduced fares also apply on the New Haven Line railroad (Metro-North) during off-peak hours only. A Medicare card or a state issued reduced fare photo I.D. is required for elderly individuals and persons with disabilities to ride on state-subsidized buses and trains for discounted rates. CTTRANSIT provides a reduced fare photo I.D. card for persons who do not have a Medicare card. There is a \$5 application fee for new cards; a \$10 processing fee is charged for replacement cards.
