- (6) Plan may only be sold on or after 1/1/06; In-force plans H,I & J with prescription drug coverage may continue to be renewed after 1/1/06 but not plans H,I or J may sold with Rx coverage on or after 1/1/06. Rates for plans H, I & J with Rx coverage are not reflected on this chart. Call specific company directly for rate information.
- (7) Plan may only be sold on or after 1/1/06. \*Out-of-pocket (OPP) limit in 2009 for Plan K = \$4,620 and for Plan L = \$2,310.
