## SENIOR MEDICARE PATROL PROGRAM (SMP)

The Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) program recruits and trains volunteers about Medicare fraud, errors and abuse. These volunteers empower and assist Medicare beneficiaries, their families, and caregivers to prevent, detect, and report healthcare fraud, error and abuse through outreach, counseling and education.

The SMP program also addresses inquiries and complaints regarding Medicare, Medicaid and other health care or related consumer issues either by resolving matters directly or by referrals to appropriate entities.

Connecticut's SMP program is funded by the federal Administration for Community Living and is administered by the State Department on Aging. The program is operated throughout the state by the Area Agencies on Aging.
