Minutes of Inmate Commutation Hearing for September 07, 2016

The Inmate Commutation Hearing was held on September 07, 2016 at the Board of Pardons and Paroles, 55 West Main St, Waterbury, Connecticut. The following board members and support staff were in attendance:

The Chairperson called the meeting to order at 9:13 a.m. and declared the presence of a quorum. Dorigene LaRosa served as Secretary for the purpose of recording and transcribing minutes. The Chairperson Joy Chance recognized the attendance of the petitioners and other members of the public who were present. The agenda was a public hearing of all cases scheduled for Commutation consideration on the September 07, 2016 Hearing docket.

All cases were called. Upon completion of all hearings, at 10:11 a.m. the Chairperson moved that the panel enter Executive Session, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 1-231, for the purpose of deliberation on individual applications for Commutation, including matters which are and will be exempt from public disclosure, because of the following reason:

1. Discussions of matters which may involve information, the disclosure of which, would constitute an invasion of personal privacy, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Sec. 1-210 (b) (2).

Zaccagnini seconded. Unanimous.

At 10:22 a.m. upon completion of consideration of the applications, Chairperson Chance moved to end the executive session.
