

Minutes of Pardons Special Meeting held on October 9, 2013

A Special Meeting of the Pardons Board was held at J. B. Gates Correctional Institution, 131 North Bridebrook Rd., Niantic, CT 06357. The following board members and staff were in attendance:

The Chair Tindill called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m. Caren Graves served as Secretary for the purpose of recording and transcribing minutes. The meeting agenda was to hear the Clemency petition of Bonnie Jean Foreshaw, #143989.

Chair Tindill called a recess at 10:58 a.m. Proceedings resumed at 11:21 a.m.

At 1:30 p.m., Chair Tindill moved that the panel enter Executive Session, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 1-231, for the purpose of consideration of matters exempt from public disclosure, with regard to Bonnie Foreshaw's application for clemency, including matters which are and will be exempt from public disclosure, due to the following:

1. Discussions of matters which may involve information, the disclosure of which, would constitute an invasion of personal privacy, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Sec. 1-210 (b) (2), or which would otherwise result in the disclosure of information which is exempt, confidential or privileged, within the meaning of any part of subsection (b) of Sec. 1-210 of the General Statutes, or is otherwise exempt under Sec. 1-210(a) as it is otherwise provided for by any federal law or state statute.

The executive session ended at 2:48 p.m. upon completion of consideration of the Clemency petition. The Board reconvened the public portion of the meeting, Inmate Foreshaw's petition was determined, by vote, as indicated:
