- **Application:** An individual applying for admission to a correctional facility to attend a public meeting shall submit his/her name and date of birth in writing to the Unit Administrator so that a background check may be conducted. Such individuals shall also provide an address and telephone number for contact and verification purposes. The request must be received by the Unit Administrator at least 24 hours in advance of the hearing date. **Failure to comply with this requirement will result in a denial of admission to any hearing or meeting.**
- **Identification and Inspection:** Upon arrival at the facility, an individual authorized to enter the facility to attend a public meeting shall provide proper identification to include a driver's license or similar valid photo identification card. Prior to entry into the secure area of the facility, the individual shall be subject to a visual and electronic search. Articles, including but not be limited to cell phones, pagers and electronic devices in an individual's possession shall not be allowed into the secure area of the facility unless previously authorized by the Unit Administrator.
