REQUIREMENTS FOR TREE WORKERS
IN CONNECTICUT

Connecticut's law requiring commercial tree workers to qualify for certificates or licenses became effective July 1, 1919. It was revised in 1929 and is now Section 2199 of the General Statutes of 1930. Certificates are issued to qualified applicants by the Tree Protection Examining Board. This circular contains the law, the rules and regulations of the Board, and a list of the present holders of active certificates.

The Tree Protection Examining Board is made up of the Botanist, Entomologist and Forester of the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station as provided in Chapter 2199 of the Connecticut General Statutes, Revision of 1930. Its duties consist of examining the qualifications of all applicants and issuing certificates to duly qualified parties, in accordance with the statute.

Such certificates are required for any person, firm or corporation which advertises, solicits or contracts in this State to improve the condition of trees by pruning, trimming or filling cavities, or to protect them from damage by insects or disease. The law does not cover the planting and fertilization of trees or their removal, nor does it apply to the care of shrubbery.

The fee for examination is \$5.00 which covers the original certificate, valid for one year. The annual fee for renewal is \$2.00. The Board has authority to revoke any certificate for cause.

TREE PROTECTION LAW

Chapter 181, Public Acts of 1919, provided for the establishment of an examining board consisting of the Botanist, Entomologist and Forester of this Station, to examine and pass upon the qualifications of men who advertise, solicit or contract to spray, prune, fill cavities, or otherwise improve the condition of trees. This act was amended by Section 4, Chapter 76, Public Acts 1929, and now appears in the following form as Section 2199 of the General Statutes, Revision of 1930:

Section 2199. Tree protection examining board. (a) No person, firm or corporation shall advertise, solicit or contract to improve the condition of fruit, shade, forest or ornamental trees, by pruning, trimming or filling cavities, or to protect such trees from damage by insects or disease, either by spraying or any other method, without having secured a certificate as specified in subsection (b) of this section. Any person, firm or corporation failing to comply with the terms of this section shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars; provided any person may improve or protect any tree on his own premises or on the property of his employer without securing such certificate. (b) The botanist, entomologist and forester of the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station shall constitute a board to be known as the tree protection examining board, which shall, upon application from any person, firm or corporation, examine the qualifications of the applicant to improve, protect or preserve fruit, shade, ornamental or forest trees and, if satisfied that the applicant is qualified, may issue a certificate so stating; which certificate shall be valid for one year from the date of its issue, unless sooner revoked as provided in subsection (c) of this section, and may be renewed by the board for succeeding years without further examination, upon payment of the fee hereinafter required, provided any person, firm or corporation receiving such certificate shall be responsible for the acts of all employees in the performance of such work. (c) Said board shall prepare all necessary forms and prescribe all rules and regulations governing examinations, and any certificate issued under the provisions of this section may be revoked by it upon proof that unsuitable methods have been used or for other sufficient cause. (d) Each applicant for an examination shall pay a fee of five dollars in advance and a fee of two dollars for each certificate of renewal issued. All such fees may be expended by the board for any expense incurred by it in making examinations or issuing certificates, and an account of all receipts and expenditures under the provisions of this section shall be rendered annually to the comptroller.

EXAMINING BOARD

The Tree Protection Examining Board was organized in July, 1919, and, until June, 1937, consisted of the following members: Chairman, W. E. Britton, Entomologist; Vice-Chairman, G. P. Clinton, Botanist; Secretary-Treasurer, W. O. Filley, Forester.

Dr. Clinton retired as Station Botanist on June 30, 1937 and died August 13, 1937. Mr. E. M. Stoddard, the acting head of the Botanical Department, is now serving as a member of the Board.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

During the 18 years in which the Board has been issuing certificates, there have been over 500 applicants for examination and a total of 468 certificates issued. There are at present 258 active certificates; 218 of which are regular and 40 are limited to specified lines of work. The plan adopted in 1936, under which a preliminary statement or examination is required of each applicant, has worked well and will be continued subject to some modifications. On the basis of these preliminary statements, the Board decides whether or not the applicant is sufficiently qualified to warrant the expense of an examination.

Time and Place of Examinations

All examinations are held at the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station, 123 Huntington Street, New Haven, Conn. Since the members of the Board are primarily concerned with other kinds of work, they cannot give an examination at the request of every applicant but plan to hold at least four during each year. Although exact dates are not fixed, these examinations usually occur near the middle of February, May, August and November. Qualified applicants will receive due notice of the examination dates.

Knowledge Expected of an Applicant

1. Ability to identify cultivated and native trees by their common names.
2. An understanding of the processes and reactions that take place in the normal life and growth of a tree.
3. Proper methods of pruning, bracing and filling cavities.
4. A fundamental understanding of spray materials, chemical reactions of spray mixtures and the effect of each class of mixtures on both pests and trees.
5. A general familiarity with insects, particularly those that injure trees, with control measures for each.
6. A general familiarity with plant diseases, particularly those that injure trees, with control measures for each.

RULES and REGULATIONS

Certificates

Certificates shall be of two kinds, regular and limited.

1. **Regular** certificates shall be issued to those authorized to do all types of work mentioned in Section 2199 of the Statutes, namely: Pruning, trimming, filling cavities, and protecting trees from damage by insects and plant diseases by spraying or other methods.
2. **Limited** certificates (indicated by the word "Limited" in red ink across the face) shall be issued to those authorized to do only such types of work as are specified in each certificate.

Examination

1. Each person, firm or corporation required to secure a certificate under Section 2199 of the General Statutes, Revision of 1930, shall be examined as follows:

When a firm is under control of one person who is solely responsible for the contracts, methods and oversight of each piece of work, this person alone may be required to pass the examination; but when more than one person is responsible for the methods of work and oversight of same, each shall be required to take the examination. When foremen or others are given complete charge of recommending and applying treatments, they may also be required to take the examination, in so far as it relates to their work. The Examining Board shall decide in each case who shall be required to take the examination.

2. Examinations may be oral, written, or both, as shall be determined by the Board and, in general, shall cover tree species, tree life and growth, diseases and insect pests of trees with treatment for same, pruning and tree surgery.

3. All candidates for certificates will be required to fill out a preliminary examination paper and return it to the Board at least two weeks prior to the examination date. No fee will be required for this preliminary statement. On the basis of the preliminary paper, the Board will determine whether or not the applicant is qualified for further examination.

4. Final examinations will be held at the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station four or more times during each year, definite dates to be set by the Board and notices sent to qualified applicants at least one week in advance. The statutory fee of \$5.00 will be required from each applicant for the final examination.

5. After final examination, if satisfied with the qualifications of the applicant, the Board will issue a certificate good for the succeeding 12 months (unless revoked for cause), and subject to renewal for a further term of 12 months, as provided hereafter, on payment of the statutory fee of \$2.00.

6. Upon evidence of unfitness in training or improper business methods, the Board may refuse to issue a certificate, or cancel one that has been issued. Complaints based on established facts may be made to the Board on these points and, if deemed desirable by the Board, private hearings of the interested parties will be held.

Renewals

The provision of Section 2199, General Statutes of 1930, regarding renewal of certificates shall be construed by this Board as meaning the continuous possession of a certificate and not an attempt to obtain a new certificate after a long period during which the old certificate has lapsed. The following rules are hereby adopted:

1. Renewals for one year may be granted by the Board without further examination or, at its discretion, the Board may require further examination before granting such renewal. Application for a renewal must be accompanied by the statutory fee of \$2.00 per annum.

2. The secretary shall notify each certificate holder at least two weeks before his certificate expires. If a certificate has not been renewed one week after date of expiration, the holder shall be notified that it is no longer valid and that work in violation of the statute is liable to penalty.

3. An invalid certificate may be revalidated, with or without examination, at the discretion of the Board if request for such action is received within one year after expiration date and if the renewal fee for the intervening period is paid in full.

4. If application is made before the expiration date of a certificate, a demit or respite, covering a period of three years, may be issued without charge entitling the holder to obtain a renewal certificate, with or without examination as the Board may decide, at any time during the demit period on payment of the statutory fee of \$2.00 for the then current renewal year.

5. If a certificate has not been renewed after three years with, or one year without, a demit, a new application with a fee of \$5.00 shall be necessary, and another examination shall be required by the Board.

SUMMARY

The main purpose of the Connecticut law requiring all commercial tree workers to secure certificates from a Tree Protection Examining Board is to prevent inadequately trained and unscrupulous tree workers from operating in the State. It is as much for the protection of tree workers as for that of the tree owners. The certificate holders listed in this bulletin have complied with the law of the State and have satisfied this Board that they are qualified by experience and training for the certificates granted them.

The Board cannot, however, guarantee that men or firms holding certificates will always be able to solve tree problems in a satisfactory manner. Such problems often involve obscure and complex factors which are not readily determined by human agencies; consequently, mistakes in diagnosis are sometimes made, with incorrect treatment as the result. Such mistakes are less common among men of long experience and adequate training, so that we believe it is safer to intrust the care of trees to a certificate holder than to some one not qualified under the Connecticut law.

The Board has no police power, and the enforcement of the law is no more its duty than that of any citizen. It is prepared to furnish necessary information and to assist in the prosecution of violators. To secure such action, however, evidence of violations must be presented to local prosecuting officials who are authorized to issue warrants.

Certificates are issued for only one year and renewal may be refused or a certificate cancelled for cause. Information regarding questionable tree work or business practice by certificate holders is requested. The Board should also be notified of any person or firm, advertising, soliciting or contracting to do tree work, whose name is not given in the current list of certificate holders. So far as possible, these cases will be investigated and such action taken as seems necessary.
