Re: Public Voice Committee Report

The Public Voice Committee met on December 11th to discuss several topics.

The Committee reviewed plans for the then upcoming welcoming reception for the Commission's new executive director, Dr. Helen Newton. The draft agenda was discussed and finalized. Guest speakers were suggested and publicity was discussed. It was decided that Christine Palm would prepare the press release and take pictures.

The reception held on Thursday, December 19 went smoothly. Although the attendance could have been better (approximately 35 – 40) the reception achieved its objective of allowing the public to meet Dr. Newton, to have specific agencies pledge their support for the Commission and provided Dr. Newton to address the public with her vision for the Commission. The projects for the PVC for 2014 were discussed. They included creating a video (and DVD) on the CHE, assist with messaging the CLAS Standards, scheduling forums around the state (3 - 4 during the year), and sponsoring the Sabbath Week in April 2014.
