THE CONNECTICUT ARTISTS' TREE: CALL FOR ARTISTS
To Create Ornaments for the Governor's Holiday Tree

Governor M. Jodi Rell is honored to spotlight the creative talents of Connecticut's fine artists this holiday season by decorating a special evergreen tree with hand-crafted ornaments. "The Connecticut Artists' Tree" will be on display at the Governor's Residence during its annual Open House scheduled for November 30, December 1 and 2, 2007. The Governor looks forward to showcasing ornaments created by artists representing each of Connecticut's 169 towns.

Ornaments may be constructed from materials of the artist's choosing. Ornaments should measure no more than 6" in height or width and be able to hang on an evergreen tree. Completed ornaments must be delivered to the Governor's office no later than **November 1, 2007**. We regret that the ornaments will not be returned; they will be donated to a group of the Governor's choice for the 2008 holiday season.

Resident Connecticut artists interested in crafting an ornament for the Governor's 2007 tree are invited to submit a form stating their intention to participate (see below) no later than September 17th, 2007. A confirmation notice containing details for submission of ornament will be sent to all interested artists by September 30th.

Governor Rell thanks you for your interest. All participating artists will receive a letter of recognition from the Governor following the Holiday season.
