Historic Property Status Inquiries

To find out if a property has a historic designation, you may contact the State Historic Preservation Office.

Information about properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places can be searched online at: <https://www.nps.gov/nr/research/>.

We have recently begun to digitize records for properties with historic designations. Please see our new historic designation database, which includes properties in Connecticut's southern four counties. Associated geographic data and scanned documents are not yet available digitally. There is currently no database or digital list available for properties included on the State Register of Historic Places that are located in the northern four counties.

The State Historic Preservation Office maintains a research library that is open to the public by appointment, where designation and architectural survey files may be viewed.
