Visitors' Events

Format

Listings include:

- Date of event.
- Name of event.
- Location of event (including venue and street location).
- Brief description of event.
- Schedule.
- Admission.
- Telephone number for public information.
- E-Mail address for event.

Criteria

• Eligible events include community festivals, street fairs, sporting events, antique shows, maritime festivals, arts and crafts shows, film festivals, any one-time special events. Also included are summer concert series, major seasonal/holiday performances, dance companies' performances, symphony orchestras, traveling theater companies' performances, guest artists' performances in performing art venues.

- Must have confirmed date(s).
- All events must be available to the general public. No events will be listed when they are by reservation only.
- Each event listed must have available space for 100 or more spectators.
- Provides entertainment and recreation which will be of interest to the general public.
- No age restrictions.
- Events must be held in the State of Connecticut.

The following are not listed on CTvisit.com:

• No conventions, conferences, workshops or classes, seminars, contests, call for artists, award ceremonies, annual meetings, trade shows, dinners and galas, book signings, high school theatrical productions, club activities, symposiums, special events and exhibits in restaurants, standard library events other than special art events, student exhibitions, student recitals, daily-run movies at cinemas and religious events.
