INTRODUCTION TO THE FIRE SERVICE

This exciting program will focus on introducing youths ages 14 - 17 to the Fire Service. Topics to be addressed will include: Discipline; Introduction to the CT Fire Academy and what it has to offer; Fire Department Organization and Structure; Fire Science; Woodland Fires; Hazardous Materials Awareness; Fire Streams; Ladders and Search and Rescue.

This course will be conducted in strict compliance with CT Labor Department restrictions and taught by instructors from the CT Fire Academy. The section on Woodland Fires will be taught by a representative from the CT Department of Environmental Protection, Forestry Division.

Upon acceptance into the program, the student will receive an information packet prior to the start of the program. This packet will include the week's agenda and a personal information and medical form to be filled out by the student's parent/guardian.

Full protective equipment is required for the program. This includes helmet; bunker coat; gloves and 3/4 boots or bunker pants.

This program will be held in a "camp" type atmosphere. Each student will reside at the CT Fire Academy for the duration of the course. *Meals and lodging are included in the tuition.*

TARGET AUDIENCE

This program targets Junior Firefighters, Cadet Firefighters and Explorers who are affiliated with a municipal fire department and are between the ages of 14-17 years old.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Must be between the ages of 14-17 years old;
- ◆ Must be affiliated with a municipal fire department;
- ◆ Must provide proof of a physical exam which has been completed no more than 12 months prior to the start day of the program; and
- ◆ Full protective equipment is required for the program. This includes helmet; bunker coat; gloves and 3/4 boots or bunker pants.

Those students accepted into the program will receive a packet prior to the start of the program.
