This exciting program will focus on introducing youths ages 14-17 to the Fire Service. Topics to be addressed will include: Discipline; Introduction to the CT Fire Academy and what it has to offer; Fire Department Organization and Structure; Fire Science; Ropes & Knots; Hazardous Materials Awareness; Fire Streams; Ladders; and Search and Rescue.



This course will be conducted by instructors from the Connecticut Fire Service with the safety of all students held paramount. Upon acceptance into the program, the student will receive an information packet prior to the start of the program. This packet will include the week's agenda and a personal information and medical form to be filled out by the student's parent/guardian.

Full protective clothing is required for the program. This includes helmet; bunker coat; gloves and 3/4 boots or bunker pants with boots.

This program will be held in a "camp" type atmosphere. Each student will reside at the CT Fire Academy for the duration of the course. Meals and lodging are included in the tuition.

## TARGET AUDIENCE

This program targets Junior Firefighters, Cadet Firefighters and Explorers who are affiliated with a municipal fire department and are between the ages of 14-17 years old.

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENT

- Must be between the ages of 14-17 years old.
- Must be affiliated with a Municipal Fire Department.
- Must provide proof of a physical exam which has been completed no more than 12 months prior to the start day of the program.
- Protective clothing is required for the program. This includes helmet; bunker coat; gloves and 3/4 boots or bunker pants with boots.
- Program is held at the Connecticut Fire Academy in Windsor Locks.

Students applying for this course will be qualified by the Program Coordinator to develop a synergy of diverse participants and notified of their acceptance. Those students accepted into the program will receive a packet prior to the start of the program.
