# CAMEO/MARPLOT/ALOHA COMPUTER CHEMICAL PLOTTING

The CT Fire Academy is hosting the NEW ICAMEO Course, Introduction to the CAMEO Suite Training program, this program includes the newly released Cameo Chemicals' program ver. 2.0, CAMEOfm ver. 2.0, Marplot ver. 4.1, and Aloha ver. 5.4, the program is presented by Louisiana State University and the National Center for Biomedical Research and Training-NCBRT.

This FREE three day training class provides training on the fundamental elements of the new and improved CAMEO Suite of programs as they relate to emergency situations, and emergency management planning for all hazards. As such, it includes detailed technical information and hands-on practice of critical elements of the updated CAMEOfm suite and its associated programs (CAMEO CHEMICALS, CAMEOfm, MARPLOT, and ALOHA, using local Tier 2 data, local GIS/Aerial maps, and local scenario's. To better understand how the programs interface, participants are provided opportunities to practice key procedures that allow users to enhance planning and response activities associated with community risk assessments. These exercises clarify the connections between the programs and how they can enhance emergency planning and response activities. This training is great for First Responders, LEPC Members, Local Emergency Managers, Haz-Mat Technicians, Law Enforcement, Military personnel, Local GIS managers, and Health Department. Program and data CD's will be provided at no charge.
