The Town of New Canaan is accepting applications through May 31, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. for the position of Firefighter. A written examination will be held in New Canaan on June 11, 2016. There is currently no vacancy but the testing will be used to establish an eligibility list for future vacancies that occur within two years from the written examination date. We seek candidates who are motivated to work in a combination career/volunteer fire department and who maintain good physical condition. Entry level firefighters, after attending Connecticut Fire Academy Recruit Training, will work a 24/72 hour schedule.

Candidates must be 21 years of age, be a U.S. citizen, have a valid drivers' license, and no previous felony convictions. Candidates must take and pass a written examination, oral examination, medical examination, drug screening, and background investigation. Candidates must submit a valid CPAT certificate issued on or after June 11, 2015 and State of Connecticut Commission on Fire Prevention & Control or Pro Board Firefighter I certification at time of application.

The Town of New Canaan will require candidates to provide copies of your State of Connecticut / Pro Board – Firefighter I certification and Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certification with the application. www.ct.gov/cfpc.
