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General Requirements for all types of Burn Evolutions:

- Designation of Safety Officer
- Written plan for general safety considerations for live burn
- Designation of Lead Instructor for the live burn
- Assurance of proper instructor to student ratio (5 to1 best)
- Inspection plan of Personal Protective Equipment and Self Contained Breathing Apparatus
- Communication System – evacuation signal established, escape routes and assembly area designated
- Evaluations being conducted using CFPC Skill Sheets in accordance with NFPA 1001, edition 2002
- Accountability process for students, both before and after live fire training
- Plan to include pre burn plan, pre burn briefing, and student walk through
- Plan to ensure appropriate water supply for both the attack and emergency back up lines

Additional requirements for specific Burn Situations:

Acquired Structure:

- Plan to ensure building is safe in accordance with NFPA 1403

Gas Fired Training Center Burn Building (ex. CFA):

- Plan to ignite and inspect prior to evolution to insure safe operational conditions of all manual, automatic, and safety devices

Non-Gas Fired Training Center Burn Building:

- Plan to ignite and inspect prior to evolution to insure safe operational conditions of all manual, automatic, and safety devices

Exterior Props (ex. CFA):

- Plan to ignite and inspect prior to evolution to insure safe operational conditions of all manual, automatic, and safety devices
