(LCO #5561=allows a PSAP w/ISO rating of Class 1 (Milford F.D.) to use a secondary answering point w/o reduced funding to 7/1/2011) (LCO #4910=requires the Governor to proclaim September as "Public Safety Awareness Month" and requires all CT State Police troops to fly the Nat'l Law Enforcement Officers Memorial flag for each day of September) REF.
