Truck Company Operations: A Hundred Things To Do



On every fire ground there are always numerous truck company operational tactics and tasks that must be accomplished for a successful firefight. Often, due to limited manpower and resources the truck company firefighter must adapt and overcome to handle many of the situations that arise. Many of us call them “Tricks of the Trade”, but are they really just “tricks”? In this lecture, learn street-smart truck company skills, tactics and tips in forcible entry, ventilation, and portable ladder operations that will help firefighters perform their job more safely and effectively.
