(Substitute=deletes references to Fire Marshal Training Council and re-inserts Codes and Standards Committee) (LCO #3545=requires the state fire marshal and CSC, instead of the administrative services commissioner, to determine the equivalent experience for certification) REF. It also eliminates a provision requiring the commissioner to waive, at the request of a fire department chief, the test fee for a fire department member who applies for a class 1 operator's license.
