In the event of a medical emergency requiring advanced level of care, the Connecticut Fire Academy uses the Bradley International Airport Paramedics for R-5 coverage and either the Suffield or East Granby Ambulance Service as the R-2 provider.

For “routine” medical emergencies, the Suffield Medical Associates walk-in clinic is normally used. There is a CVS pharmacy conveniently located in the adjacent plaza to Suffield Medical Associates for prescriptions etc.

Please check with your “Risk Management” office or worker’s compensation provider if this is not their desired provider.
