Billy is a retired Battalion Chief of the New York City Fire Department (FDNY). His FDNY career spanned over 27 years. As a Captain, he chaired a committee that researched and created an SOP for operations in buildings of light weight construction. His assignment as a Chief brought him to Manhattan to supervise operations in one of the most high profile areas of the city. One of several sensitive landmark sites in his district was Penn Station and its associated tunnel system where he formalized and coordinated response and operational procedures. He was a member of the FDNY's Incident Management Team. Chief Hines is currently a Senior Instructor for the National Transit Institute, an educational subsidy of the Federal Transit Administration, who provides safety and educational programs for transportation agencies.

New officers will soon realize that their recent promotion is more than just a newly colored helmet and a different title. From dealing with station situations that can frustrate even a seasoned officer, to making things "happen" on the fire ground and at the fire station, we will share their experiences to help prepare you for the officer challenge. The course features an introduction to strategy and tactics, ICS and safety concerns. Students will participate in various role plays, interactive problem solving exercises and fire simulation scenarios. **This program is appropriate for newly appointed company officers and firefighters looking toward their next promotion.**
