- All cooking must be done on premises.
- Set up will begin no earlier than **12:00pm**.
- Cooking will begin no earlier than **1:00pm**.
- Chili must be ready to judge by **5:00pm**.
- Only USDA meat may be used.
- Each team must prepare a minimum of 5 gallons of chili.
- Sample cups and spoons will be provided.
- Each team must supply any heat sources, pots, pans, cookware, crock pots, etc.
- Each team must provide their own utensils for cooking, chopping, preparing and serving.

Provisions:

- Each team will be provided with an 8' work table and an 8' serving table. Power will be available.
- Each team will receive a \$100.00 IGA gift certificate to purchase supplies.
- Each Department will be provided with 3 All Access Passes for their team. This pass includes access to all event areas, including our Dream Ride Experience Party. If additional passes are needed, they will be available at a reduced rate of \$15 per pass. Please contact Danielle Zercie at 203.250.5391 for additional passes.

Additional Information:
