June Fire School Course Update as of May 20th

Seats remain available for the majority of the 2010 June Fire School classes at the Connecticut Fire Academy which is scheduled from Monday June 7th through Saturday June 12th. Two extremely valuable classes offered this year are Introduction to CAMEO and Advanced CAMEO. These classes are available on a federal grant and include extensive take home materials. The only cost to the student is for the food service which is not covered by the grant. CAMEO classes are appropriate for the fire service, law enforcement, emergency medical services, public health, hazardous material response, public works, emergency managers, and public safety communications agencies.

The following classes are full at this time.

- Forcible Entry class scheduled for Monday June 7th
- Ladder Company Priorities class scheduled for Tuesday June 8th
- Engine Company Operations: Advancing the Initial Handline scheduled for Tuesday June 8th and Wednesday June 9th
- Collapse Rescue Shoring for Firefighters scheduled for Wednesday June 9th and Thursday June 10th
- Pump Simulator for Training and Testing scheduled for Wednesday June 9th
- Basic Pump Operations scheduled for Monday June 7th and Tuesday June 8th
- Advanced Vehicle Extrication scheduled for Tuesday June 8th and Wednesday June 9th
- Engine Company Operations: Emergency Action Drills scheduled for Friday June 11th
- Introduction to Rope Rescue Systems scheduled for Tuesday June 8th
- Rapid Intervention Team scheduled for Wednesday June 9th and Thursday June 10th

Any additional applications for these classes will be wait-listed.
