June Fire School Course Update as of May 20th

Seats remain available for the majority of the 2010 June Fire School classes at the Connecticut Fire Academy which is scheduled from Monday June 7th through Saturday June 12th. Two extremely valuable classes offered this year are Introduction to CAMEO and Advanced CAMEO. These classes are available on a federal grant and include extensive take home materials. The only cost to the student is for the food service which is not covered by the grant. CAMEO classes are appropriate for the fire service, law enforcement, emergency medical services, public health, hazardous material response, public works, emergency managers, and public safety communications agencies.

Pump Simulator for Training and Testing - Wednesday June 9th

Basic Pump Operations - Monday June 7th and Tuesday June 8th

Advanced Vehicle Extrication - Tuesday June 8th and Wednesday June 9th

Engine Company Operations: Emergency Action Drills - Friday June 11th

Introduction to Rope Rescue Systems - Thursday June 10th

Rapid Intervention Team - Wednesday June 9th and Thursday June 10th
