### **CHARTER OAK HEALTH PLAN NOW AVAILABLE**

Governor Rell announced the launch of the Charter Oak Health Plan on June 30, 2008. The plan, administered by the Department of Social Services, provides affordable health care for Connecticut's uninsured adults who are too old for HUSKY but too young for Medicare. For the first time, Connecticut adults who aren't lucky enough to get health insurance on the job will have access to decent, affordable coverage.

A toll free hotline, 1-877-77-CTOAK (1-877-772-8625), has been set up for the public to get more information about Charter Oak. The line will be open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Fridays and from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturdays.
