*****NOTICE CONCERNING CLAIMS-MADE**

CYBER LIABILITY INSURANCE ***

This Notice concerns the Connecticut Insurance Department's (the "Department") approval for licensed insurers to use claims-made policy forms for Cyber Liability insurance coverage. Pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies section 38a-327-2(11), the Department has received requests for the use of claims-made policy forms in connection with cyber liability insurance coverage¹. The Department believes that such coverage is fairly unique and not generally available in the marketplace. As a result, the Insurance Commissioner hereby approves the filing of cyber liability insurance coverage forms on a claims-made basis. As a reminder, all such forms are subject to the requirements of the Insurance Department's Claims-made Liability Insurance Policies regulations that may be found on-line at: http://www.sots.ct.gov/sots/lib/sots/regulations/title_38a/327.pdf.
