### ANNUAL BAIL BOND ASSESSMENT OF \$450.00 DUE BY JANUARY 31, 2017

#### *New Convenient Online Payment System Eliminates Paper Checks*

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On **11/14/16**, the Insurance Department will be transitioning to an online credit card processing system for the payment of the annual surety bail bond assessment. This new payment system is a convenient online transaction aimed at improving regulatory efficiencies for all licensees.

Go to the CID website at [WWW.CT.GOV/CID](http://WWW.CT.GOV/CID) and select the “bail bonds regulation” link in order to make your payment online.

**Please be advised that checks will no longer be accepted as a payment method for assessments and assessment invoices will no longer be sent regular mail to individual licensees or their related business entities. Instead (1) email reminder will be sent to each individual licensee. It is up to licensees to pay the individual assessment, as well as that of any applicable business entity. Failure to pay such is a violation and will result in Departmental sanctions.**

In order to ensure that you receive your assessment invoices in the future, you must provide the Department with your individual and business email addresses.

**NOTE:** Licensees are responsible for keeping demographic information, including email addresses, updated at all times. The Department is **not** responsible for lost, misdirected or unpaid assessments. Failure to keep contact information updated may also result in administrative sanctions pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes 38a-660, 38a-771 and 38a-774.
