Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 38a-474 of the Connecticut General Statutes, a public hearing will be held before the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Connecticut on Wednesday, February 23, 2011, 9:00 a.m. at 153 Market St, 6th Floor, Conference Room 600, Hartford, CT 06103.

This hearing will be held to consider the rate increase filing made by Oxford Life Insurance Company on its Medicare supplement insurance policy forms. The hearing will be held in accordance with the authority granted to the Insurance Commissioner under Sections 38a-474 and 38a-495a of the Connecticut General Statutes and Sections 38a-474-2 and 38a-495a-10 of the regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

The rate increase filing that will be considered at this public hearing concerns the company's individual Standardized Medicare supplement insurance policy forms.
