Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 38a-8 of the Connecticut General Statutes, a public hearing will be held before the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Connecticut on Tuesday, October 21, 2008 at 9:00 a.m., Legislative Office Building, 300 Capital Avenue, Hartford, CT 06106, Conference room 1B.

This hearing will be held to consider the rate filings made by Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield on its Medicare supplement insurance policy forms.

The rate filings that will be considered at this public hearing concern the company's pre-standardized and standardized Medicare supplement insurance products. The proposed rate changes for the company's plans are as follows:


