D E C I S I O N A N D O R D E R

The application of the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection for an amendment to the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need issued by the Power Facility Evaluation Council (now Connecticut Siting Council) in its Docket No. 22, for the construction of a telecommunication tower on Birch Mountain Road, Glastonbury, is hereby granted. This approval is authorized pursuant to section 16-50k(c) of the general statutes of Connecticut, revised to 1981, and is made for the reasons described in the Opinion accompanying this Decision and Order.

The Applicant has requested an extension of the time limit for construction which conditioned the certificate. In deciding to grant this request, the Council finds that the public need for the facility remains the same as found in the original proceeding and no environmental effects incremental to those identified in the original proceeding will occur.

Accordingly, it is hereby ordered that an amended Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need be issued to the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to the provisions of section 16-50k of the general statutes. Condition number 5, Time Limitation, in the Decision and Order for Docket No. 22, dated April 1, 1981, is hereby amended to read. If the

construction authorized in the Council's Decision and Order for Docket No. 22, dated April 1, 1981, is not completed before April 3, 1983, that Decision and Order shall be void.


