D E C I S I O N A N D O R D E R

Pursuant to the Council's opinion in this matter, the Council hereby directs that a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need as required by section 16-50k of the General Statutes of Connecticut, revisions of 1958, revised to 1981, as amended, shall be issued to Valley Cable Vision, Incorporated, for the modification of its head-end facility on Great Hill Road, Seymour, Connecticut, as specified in the Council's record on this matter, subject to the following conditions:

1. The replacement tower structure shall be no taller or wider than necessary to provide the proposed service and in no event shall it exceed 250 feet in height and six feet in width;
2. The existing tower and the existing earth station antennae shall be dismantled and removed within six months of successful operation of the replacement equipment;
3. A screened fence not lower than six feet shall surround the tower and earth station equipment;
4. No equipment other than that referred to in Council finding number 12 shall be added to the replacement tower without prior notification to the Council, even if, in the certificate holder's opinion, no Council action is required;
5. Following installation and initiation of operation of CATV equipment on the replacement tower, power densities shall be

measured to confirm the levels cited in Council finding 27 and reported to the Council with a qualified engineer's certification;

6. The tower shall be reinforced by a three-guy support system;
7. The applicant shall submit a development and management plan pursuant to sections 16-50j-75 through 16-50j-77 of the regulations of state agencies except that irrelevant items in section 16-50j-76 need only be identified as such;
8. The facility modification shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable state and municipal laws and regulations; and
9. This decision and order shall be void if all construction authorized is not completed by November 5, 1984.

We hereby direct, pursuant to section 16-50p(c) of the General Statutes, that a copy of the opinion and decision and order be served on each person listed below. A notice of the issuance shall be published in the Bridgeport Post and the Seymour Evening Sentinel.


