DECISION AND ORDER

Pursuant to the foregoing Opinion, the Council hereby directs that a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need as required by section 16-50k of the General Statutes of Connecticut, revisions of 1958, revised to 1983, as amended, be issued to Continental Cablevision of Connecticut, Incorporated, for the erection of a community antenna television head-end tower, earth stations, and associated equipment on Chestnut Mountain Road, Stafford, as specified in the Council's record on this matter, subject to the following conditions:

1. The head-end tower shall be no taller or wider than necessary to provide the proposed service, and in no event shall it exceed 150 feet in height as proposed in the application;
2. A fence not lower than eight feet shall surround the tower and earth station facilities;
3. No associated equipment other than that referred to in Council finding number 12 shall be added to the tower site without prior notification to the Council;
4. Following the installation and initiation of operation of CATV equipment on the head-end tower, power densities shall be measured to confirm the predicted levels cited in Council finding number 40 and reported to the Council with a qualified engineer's certification;

5. The applicant shall seek to amend its agreement with the property owner to preclude the removal of vegetation between the tower site and Chestnut Mountain Road and report results to the Council in the final report of the development and management plan required by Order 6, below.
6. The applicant shall submit a development and management plan (D&M) pursuant to sections 16-50j-75 through 16-50j-77 of the regulations of state agencies except that irrelevant items in section 16-50j-76 need only be identified as such. The D&M shall include provisions for planting screening vegetation wherever appropriate;
7. Unless precluded by the provisions of Order number 8, below, no lights shall be installed on the tower above 20 feet;
8. The facility construction shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws and regulations; and
9. This decision and order shall be void if all construction authorized is not completed by October 17, 1985.

We hereby direct, pursuant to section 16-50p(c) of the General Statutes, that a copy of the opinion and decision and order be served on each person listed below. A notice of the issuance shall be published in the Hartford Courant and the Journal Inquirer.


