

AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CONNECTICUT RESOURCES RECOVERY AUTHORITY FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPATIBILITY AND PUBLIC NEED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATION OF AN ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY IN THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, CONNECTICUT. : CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL : August 16, 1985

DECISION AND ORDER

The application submitted by the Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority (CRRRA) for Signal Resco to construct and operate a refuse-to-energy generating facility is hereby approved. A certificate of environmental compatibility and public need, as required by section 16-50k of the Connecticut General Statutes, shall be issued, subject to the following terms, limitations, and conditions. Any changes to specifications pertaining to the following conditions, development and management plan, and notice and report requirements will require Council approval no less than two weeks prior to such change.

1. Conditions

- a) The facility shall be constructed as proposed in the application, as amended and as detailed in the Council's record;
- b) The construction and operation of the facility shall be in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws, regulations, and ordinances;
- c) The facility shall be constructed in such a manner so as not to preclude future utilization of waterfront access and/or water based transportation to the site;
- d) The certificate holder shall, prior to commencement of operation, provide a water supply contingency plan that shall include

available alternative sources of water supply and/or alternative operating specifications and projected operating levels under such conditions;

e) This certificate will be void if all construction authorized herein is not completed by October 1, 1989.

2. Development and Management Plan

The certificate holder shall, prior to the commencement of construction, submit for the Council's approval a Development and Management Plan (D&M) providing the following:

- a) a finalized site plan showing roads, buildings and structures, and the location of any long-term demolition or construction material stockpiles;
- b) a finalized schedule of demolition, construction, testing, and operations activities.

In preparing the D&M plan, the applicant may consult with Council staff. The Council shall approve, modify, or disapprove the D&M plan within 30 days of filing.

3. Notifications

The certificate holder shall provide to the Council two weeks in advance these notifications:

- a) commencement of demolition;
- b) commencement of construction;
- c) commencement of testings; and
- d) commencement of operation.

4. Reports

The certificate holder shall provide the following reports to the Council:

- a) a quarterly progress report on the project, commencing three months after the date of this order;
- b) final plans for the disposal of residue ash, by-pass MSW, and OBW that meet the need to dispose of all residual wastes from the facility for the entire term of the project;
- c) an environmental evaluation of the cooling tower blowdown discharge in Cedar Creek, to be submitted 6 and 18 months after the commencement of operations;
- d) the results of air emission testing and the final DEP air compliance permit;
- e) a final report, to be submitted upon completion of construction, that includes the final cost of the project, demolition costs, salvage values, participating communities, total daily waste volumes to be expected, tipping fees, and other information considered relevant to the cost and operation of the facility.

Pursuant to section 16-50p of the General Statutes, we hereby direct that a copy of the Opinion and Decision and Order shall be served on each person listed below. A notice of the issuance shall be published in the Bridgeport Post.
