AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY OGDEN MARTIN SYSTEMS, INC., FOR THE BRISTOL RESOURCE RECOVERY PROJECT FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPATIBILITY AND PUBLIC NEED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATION OF AN ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY IN THE CITY OF BRISTOL, CONNECTICUT. : CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL August 29, 1985

D E C I S I O N A N D O R D E R

The application submitted by Ogden Martin Systems, Inc., for Ogden Martin Systems of Bristol, Inc., to construct and operate a refuse-to-energy generating facility is hereby approved. A certificate of environmental compatibility and public need, as required by section 16-50k of the Connecticut General Statutes, shall be issued, subject to the following terms, limitations, and conditions. Any changes to specifications pertaining to the following conditions, development and management plan, and notice and report requirements will require Council approval no less than two weeks prior to such change.

1. Conditions

- a) The facility shall be constructed as proposed in the application, as amended and as detailed in the Council's record;
- b) The construction and operation of the facility shall be in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws, regulations, and ordinances;
- c) The certificate holder shall, prior to commencement of operation, provide a water supply contingency plan that shall include available alternative sources of water supply and/or alternative operating specifications and projected operating levels under such conditions; and

d) This certificate will be void if all construction authorized herein is not completed by April 30, 1989.

2. Development and Management Plan

The certificate holder shall, prior to the commencement of construction, submit for the Council's approval, a Development and Management Plan (D&M) providing the following:

- a) a site plan showing all roads, grading, structures and environmental mitigation controls, and the location of any long-term construction material stockpiles;
- b) a plan to mitigate any incremental degradation of water quality, including natural and/or artificial water bodies, on or off the site, that may occur as a result of the development of the facility; and
- c) a schedule of site preparation, construction, testing and operation activities.

In preparing the D&M plan, the applicant may consult with the Council staff. The Council shall approve, modify, or disapprove the D&M plan within 30 days of filing.

3. Notifications

The certificate holder shall provide to the Council two weeks in advance the following notifications:

- a) commencement of construction;
- b) commencement of testing; and
- c) commencement of operation.

4. Reports

The certificate holder shall provide to the Council the following reports, which may be consolidated as appropriate:

- a) a quarterly progress report on the project, commencing three months after the date of this order;
- b) an evaluation of water quality of all run-off and discharge flowing off the site conducted no sooner than three months after commencement of operation and due six months after commencement of operation;
- c) the results of air emission testing and the final DEP air compliance permit;
- d) documentation of compliance with all applicable state and municipal noise regulation by testing conducted under normal operating conditions no sooner than one month after commencement of operations, due six months after commencement of operations; and
- e) a final report that includes the final cost of the project, participating communities, total daily waste volumes, cost and status of residue ash and by-pass MSW disposal plans for the operating life of the facility, tipping fees, recovery credits, and other information relevant to the cost and operation of the facility, due six months after commencement of operation.

Pursuant to section 16-50p of the General Statutes, we hereby direct that a copy of the Opinion and Decision and Order shall be served on each person listed below. A notice of the issuance shall be published in the Bristol Press.
