

JOINT APPLICATION OF UNITED CABLE TELEVISION SERVICES CORPORATION AND UNITED CABLE TELEVISION CORPORATION OF CONNECTICUT FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPATIBILITY AND PUBLIC NEED TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY ANTENNA TELEVISION HEAD-END FACILITY IN THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, CONNECTICUT. : CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL : February 19, 1986

D E C I S I O N A N D O R D E R

Pursuant to the foregoing opinion, the Council hereby directs that a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need as required by section 16-50k of the General Statutes of Connecticut (CGS) be issued to United Cable Television Services and United Cable Television Corporation of Connecticut, collectively, the Companies, for the modification of an existing television broadcast tower site and the construction, maintenance, and operation of a Community Antenna Television head-end facility in the Town of Farmington, Connecticut. Any changes to specifications pertaining to the following conditions will require Council approval no less than two weeks prior to such changes.

Conditions

1. The facilities shall be constructed, operated, and maintained and the existing facilities shall be removed as specified in the Council's record on this matter and in the final site plan required by Condition 10, below;
2. The six microwave dishes on the existing Channel 61 tower shall be placed no higher on the tower than necessary to provide the proposed service, and in no event shall exceed the 500' level of the tower;
3. The certificate holder shall provide notice of the addition of any other CATV equipment to the tower, which equipment shall be subject to the provisions of section 16-50j-72 of the

Regulations of State Agencies (RSA);

4. All proposed activities shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws and regulations;
5. If any legal action requires the removal of the tower, all CATV equipment on the tower shall also be removed;
6. The certificate holder shall measure the actual radio frequency power density levels at the head-end site and at the nearest residence on Pinnacle Road once the facilities become operational and report such results to the Council;
7. The certificate holder shall install notch filters if necessary to eliminate terrestrial interference problems before erecting an interference fence;
8. New fencing shall be screened with evergreen trees;
9. The certificate holder shall comply with the reporting requirements of RSA section 16-50j-77 but no D&M plan pursuant to RSA section 16-50j-75 will be required;
10. Prior to commencement of clearing for the access road or earth station construction, the certificate holder shall provide a final site plan showing the final access road and earth station locations;
11. The certificate holder shall cooperate with the owner of the tower and undertake all actions necessary with equipment owned and operated by the certificate holder to comply with governmental noise standards or agreements regarding mitigation of noise from the structure; and
12. This decision and order shall be void if all construction authorized is not completed within three years of the issuance of this decision.

Pursuant to CGS section 16-50p, we hereby direct that a copy of the decision and order shall be served on each person listed below. A notice of the issuance shall be published in the Hartford Courant and the New Britain Herald.
