DECISION AND ORDER

The Connecticut Siting Council hereby amends the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need issued on May 7, 1986, pursuant to section 16-50k of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Hartford Hospital Cogeneration Facility. The amendment is issued subject to the following terms, limitations, and conditions.

1. Conditions:

- a. the Facility shall be constructed substantially as proposed in the application in Docket 60, except as amended and detailed in the Council's record in Docket 60A;
- b. the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Facility shall be in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws, regulations, ordinances, codes, and standards;
- c. existing ambient noise levels shall comply with all state and local noise regulations and standards; and
- d. this amendment shall be void if all construction authorized herein is not completed by November 1, 1989.

2. Notification:

The Certificate holder shall provide to the Council two weeks advance notification of the following:

- a. commencement of testing; and
- b. commencement of operation.

3. Reports:

The Certificate holder shall provide to the Council the following reports:

- a. a quarterly progress report;
- b. the final approved state air emission permit to operate, when available;
- c. the final National Pollution Discharge Elimination System and state discharge permits, when available; and
- d. documentation of compliance with state noise regulations, due no later than six months after commencement of operation. Documentation is to be in the form of day and night time testing conducted under normal operating conditions no sooner than one month after the commencement of operations.

Pursuant to section 16-50p of the CGS, we hereby direct that a copy of the Opinion and the Decision and Order shall be served on each person listed below and that notice of the issuance shall be published in the Hartford Courant.
