Dear Attorney McDermott:

At a public meeting held on June 28, 2005, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) considered and approved Phenix Environmental, Inc. as the Environmental Inspector for the United Illuminating portion of construction in this docket pursuant to the Council's Decision and Order, item No. 20 dated April 7, 2005. Further, this approval stipulates that Phenix submit a weekly report to the Council and the chief elected official of each affected municipality. Issues also needing immediate attention be resolved at the Chairman's discretion through staff followed with documentation filed by the Certificate Holder. All other changes to the D&M Plan as approved by the Council require advance Council notification and approval.

Any deviation from the D&M plans may result in the Council implementing enforcement proceedings pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50u including, without limitation, imposition of expenses resulting from such failure and of civil penalties in an amount not less than one thousand dollars per day for each day of construction or operation in material violation.
