Question No. 1

Listed below are the data from the March 2006 ISO-New England Seasonal Claimed Capability Report (rounded to two decimal places). Does Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (Dominion) agree with the numbers listed below? If no, provide the most up to date data.

<b>Net Capability – MW</b>	<b>Summer</b>	<b>Winter</b>
<b>Millstone Point 2</b>	882.14	881.96
<b>Millstone Point 3</b>	1155.00	1155.48

Response

Dominion agrees with the numbers.

Question No. 2

How does Dominion compute seasonal claimed capability?

Response

Dominion computes seasonal claimed capability in accordance with the process contained in “ISO-NE Manual 20, Installed Capacity”, current revision.

Question No. 3

Provide the status of the license renewal process for both Unit 2 and Unit 3.

Response

On November 28, 2005, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) announced that it had renewed the operating licenses of the Millstone Power Station Units 2 and 3 for an additional 20 years. With this renewal, the operating license for Unit 2 is extended to July 31, 2035 and the operating license for Unit 3 is extended to November 25, 2045.

Question No. 4

Are the upgrades to the low pressure turbine rotors complete for Unit 2 and Unit 3?

Response

Yes.

Question No. 5

Review the 2005 report titled *Connecticut Siting Council Review of the Forecast of Connecticut Electric Loads and Resources*, and provide any comments that may be helpful in the preparation of the 2006 report. For example, are there any new topics that Dominion believes should be addressed in the 2006 report that were not covered in the 2005 report?

Response

Dominion finds the Siting Council’s report to be comprehensive and a useful planning tool for Connecticut.

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
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
