1. In reference to the existing list of generating facilities in service, please provide the location of the facility by ISO-RSP Zone and describe the ability of each to provide (a) operating reserves (i.e., capacity by ISO reserve category) into the Locational Forward Reserve Market, and (b) a quick start capability.

Lake Road Response:

Lake Road Generating Company, LP ("Lake Road") has three gas-fired combined cycle generating facilities which are physically located in Dayville, Connecticut. They are currently identified by ISO-NE as located in the Rhode Island NE Regional System Plan ("RSP") Zone.¹

From an on-line state, all three generating units are capable of providing synchronized reserve which could satisfy the physical response capability needed to satisfy Rest of System Ten Minute Non-Spin Reserves and Thirty Minute Operating Reserves requirements under the Locational Forward Reserve Market ("LFRM").² Under current operations, all three units require greater than 30 minutes to start from an off-line state and are therefore not considered quick start by ISO-NE.

2. In relation to the list of planned generating facilities, please provide the location of the facility by ISO-NE RSP Zone and describe the ability of each to provide (a) operating reserves (i.e., capacity by ISO reserve category) into the Locational Forward Reserve Market, and (b) a quick start capability.

Lake Road Response:

Lake Road has no firm plans for additional generating facilities in the ISO-NE RSP zone.

¹ As part of the ISO-NE's Forward Capacity Market qualification process, Lake Road has requested review of its Unit No. 2 as a capacity resource located inside the Connecticut Capacity Zone and is currently awaiting the completion of that ISO-NE evaluation.

² Under the design of the ISO-NE LRFM, the portion of a resource designated as supplying any category of reserve in the LRFM must offer the associated energy at a price which exceeds an ISO-NE defined threshold price. Qualification as reserve under LRFM requires the resource to meet both the physical (response capability) and energy offer price criteria.

3. (a) Please identify all generating units (by name and capacity) that currently operate under "RMR Contract" with ISO New England, or other such contracts that supplement revenues available through ISO administered markets. (b) Please identify the current termination date of each such contract.

Lake Road Response:

None of the Lake Road generating units currently operate under "RMR Contract" with ISO-NE, or other such contracts that supplement revenues available through ISO-NE administered markets. Lake Road occasionally enters into bilateral contracts with market participants to sell wholesale power products to hedge all or part of the revenues available through ISO-NE administered markets.
