

**RE: CGS Section 16-50r input to forecast of loads and resources
Bridgeport Energy LLC**

Dear Mr. Phelps:

Bridgeport Energy LLC hereby submits to the Connecticut Siting Council information as required by Connecticut General Statute Section 16-50r. As an entity that generates electric power in the state utilizing a generating facility with capacity greater than one megawatt, Bridgeport Energy is required to provide responses to subdivisions (3), (4), (5), and (8). These responses are as follows:

(3) A list of existing generating facilities in service.

Bridgeport Energy Facility, located at 10 Atlantic St., Bridgeport, CT, a 520 MW combined cycle power generating plant using pipeline natural gas.

(4) A list of scheduled generating facilities for which property has been acquired, for which certificates have been issued and for which certificate applications have been filed.

None with direct respect to Bridgeport Energy LLC, the entity filing this report. Please note, however, that Bridgeport Energy II, LLC has filed petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed construction and operation of a 350 MW peaking facility to be located at the existing Bridgeport Energy LLC plant. Bridgeport Energy II, LLC, which will own and operate the proposed peaking facility, is a wholly owned subsidiary of a joint venture of LS Power Associates, L.P. and Dynegy Inc. Bridgeport Energy LLC is a subsidiary of Dynegy Inc., but is not itself the applicant for the proposed peaking facility.

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(5) A list of planned generating units at plant locations for which property has been acquired, or at plant locations not yet acquired, that will be needed to provide estimated additional electrical requirements, and the location of such facilities.


