TO PRE-HEARING INTERROGATORIES

Question No. 1

Listed below are the data from the June 2009 ISO-New England Seasonal Claimed Capability Report (June 2009 SCC Report), rounded to two decimal places. Does Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (Dominion) agree with the numbers listed below? If no, provide the most up to date data.

Net Capability – MW	Summer	Winter
Millstone Point 2	876.92	871.22
Millstone Point 3	1137.48	1237.20

Response

A revised table follows:

Net Capability – MW	Summer	Winter
Millstone Point 2	869.11	871.22
Millstone Point 3	1233.40	1237.20

The Summer claimed net capabilities for Units 2 and 3 have been demonstrated on June 17, 2009, and are reflected in the revised table.

Question No. 2

When was the approximately 80 MW upgrade to Millstone Unit 3 completed?

Response

Unit 3 power uprate was successfully implemented during the Fall 2008 refueling outage (3R12). Following the completion of the outage, the MW output from the unit was increased to the NRC approved limit. The increase was reflected in the December 23, 2008, Winter claimed net capability demonstration.

Question No. 3

Is the approximately 80 MW increase in power output from Millstone No. 3 reflected in the June 2009 SCC Report?

Response

The approximate 80 MW increase in power output from Millstone Power Station Unit 3 (Millstone Point 3) is reflected in the claimed net capability in the revised table in the answer to Question 1.


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
