
Dear Mr. Ginnetti:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, July 15, 2009, to review the 2009 Ten-Year Forecast of Connecticut Electric Loads and Resources. The hearing will be held Hearing Room One, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at 2:00 p.m., continuing at 6:30 p.m., and thereafter as necessary. The hearing is being held pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50r.

The purpose of the hearing is to provide an opportunity for cross-examination by parties and intervenors and public comment.

Any person seeking to be admitted as a party or intervenor to the proceeding may file a written petition to be so designated at the office of the Council, 10 Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut 06051, on or before July 8, 2009. Parties and intervenors, and persons wishing to participate as parties or intervenors, are requested to submit pre-filed testimony to the Council on or before July 8, 2009.

Parties and intervenors are required to serve the Council with an original and 15 copies and all other parties and intervenors with one copy of any material submitted to this docket, unless service is waived. A list of parties and intervenors of record is available from the Council.

Any person who is not a party or intervenor to the proceeding may file a written statement with the Council at the hearing or any time up to 30 days thereafter. Such statements will become part of the record.

All testimony at the hearing will be taken under oath, and each witness will be subject to cross-examination by the Council and all parties and intervenors. The record of this proceeding is available for public inspection at the office of the Council, 10 Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut 06051.

Requests for information in alternative formats or for sign-language interpreter services must be submitted in writing by July 8, 2009.

CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL E-MAIL SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS

Pursuant to Section 16-1-15 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is offering the use of e-mail to deliver its outgoing documents and for service among participants. Individuals and companies can elect to receive most regulatory documents by e-mail rather than by U.S. mail. (Final Decisions will still be sent certified mail to participants.) The service list for each proceeding will identify those who have agreed to electronic service and their e-mail address(es). The Council emphasizes that those who accept e-mail delivery do not give up their right to request copies of bulk items or specific filings as necessary. If a request is received, the participant who generated the document(s) should provide the hard copy(ies).

Please note, however, that all proceeding submissions to the Council still need to be filed with an original and 15 copies for staff and Council member distribution, as well as an electronic filing to facilitate the Council's ability to place pending proceeding documents of the record on the Council's website ([www.ct.gov/csc](http://www.ct.gov/csc) under the link Pending Proceedings).
