

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council on or about August 25, 2003, by Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. ("DNC") to establish an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation ("ISFSI") at the Millstone Power Station ("Millstone") in Waterford, Connecticut.

The ISFSI would be located in the southerly portion of the 520-acre Millstone property, adjacent to the existing power generating units. The ISFSI will provide for the interim storage of spent nuclear fuel within steel dry-shielded canisters, stored inside reinforced concrete horizontal storage modules. The location and other features of the ISFSI are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50g, *et seq.*
