**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**  
**TO RESPOND TO REMAINING INTERROGATORIES**

The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) respectfully requests an extension of time to December 15, 2011 to complete responses to the remaining Interrogatories issued by (a) the Connecticut Siting Council (CSC) and (b) the Office of Consumer Counsel, both dated October 21, 2011. CL&P completed and filed responses to eight of the Interrogatories on November 10, 2011. However, due to the unprecedented outages caused by the winter storm on October 29, 2011, Company personnel with expertise in the subject matter of the remaining Interrogatory responses were required to stay on field assignment through the end of the last work week to handle storm restoration duties and were unable to work on these responses while fulfilling their essential field duties. Consequently, CL&P is requesting this extension of time.

To the extent possible, CL&P will provide the remaining responses to these Interrogatories as they are completed.
