

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NOTICE OF HEARING ON CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL INVESTIGATION INTO THE LIFE-CYCLE COSTS OF ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINES

Connecticut Siting Council
LIFE-CYCLE 2011

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 15, 2011 to review Life-Cycle Cost Studies Comparing Overhead and Underground Alternatives for Electric Transmission Lines. The hearing will be held at 10 Franklin Square, in Hearing Room One, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at 2:00 p.m., continuing at 6:30 p.m., and thereafter as necessary. This hearing is being held pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50r(b).

The purpose of the hearing is to review the comparative costs of overhead and underground electric transmission lines including all relevant life-cycle costs, relative reliability, constraints concerning access and construction, potential damage to the environment, and compatibility with the existing electric supply system. As part of this investigation, the Council will update, as necessary, the information contained in the "Life-Cycle 2007 - Connecticut Siting Council Investigation into Life-Cycle Costs of Electric Transmission Lines" Report.

Any person seeking to be admitted as a party or intervenor to the proceeding may file a written petition to be so designated at the office of the Council, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, 06051, on or before November 8, 2011. Parties and intervenors, and persons wishing to participate as parties or intervenors are requested to submit pre-filed testimony by November 8, 2011.

Parties and intervenors are required to serve the Council with an original and 15 copies, and all other parties and intervenors with one copy of any material submitted in this docket, unless service is waived.

Any person who is not a party or intervenor to the proceeding may make an oral statement during the 6:30 p.m. session or file a written statement with the Council at any time up to 30 days after the hearing. Such statements will become part of the record.

All testimony at the hearing will be taken under oath, and each witness will be subject to cross-examination by the Council and all parties and intervenors. The record of this proceeding is available for public inspection at the office of the Council, 10 Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut 06051.

Requests for information in alternative formats or for sign-language interpreter services must be submitted in writing by November 8, 2011.






