Re: Life-Cycle 2011 – Connecticut Siting Council Investigation into the Electric

Dear Chairman Stein:

The United Illuminating Company (“UI” or “Company”) respectfully requests that the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) grant an extension of time until November 14, 2011 for the Company’s filing of responses to Interrogatories from the Council and the Office of Consumer Counsel. As the Council has asked The Connecticut Light and Power Company (“CL&P”), UI will file as many responses as possible before the close of business on November 11, 2011.

The requested extension reflects the fact that the Company personnel who are involved in this filing are the same personnel who have been fully engaged in Winter Storm Alfred (many of whom are now assisting CL&P with their restoration activities). Accordingly, more time is needed for such personnel to re-focus their efforts on the filings noted above.
