Ladies and Gentlemen:

As you are undoubtedly aware, a physical plant emergency of a presently undetermined nature has taken place at the generator site of Kleen Energy Systems, LLC ("Kleen"), as of approximately 11:30 AM Eastern time on Sunday, February 7, 2010.


To the best of Kleen's present knowledge, the plant emergency involved an explosion, possibly caused by the release and combustion of natural gas, located on or adjacent to Kleen's premises. As the investigation of this emergency is still ongoing, it has not yet determined whether the said release and combustion occurred on gas lines owned or controlled by Kleen. While Kleen is not yet certain what effect the explosion may have had on Kleen's facility or Kleen's anticipated in-service and operational dates, Kleen recognizes that the explosion was of a serious nature.

By separate letter, Kleen also has requested that ISO-NE and CL&P recognize the urgent nature of the present situation and also accept this notice under the ISO's Market Rules, including if necessary (but not limited to) in full satisfaction of the ISO's FERC Electric Tariff No. 3, Market Rule 1, Section III.13; and/or the ISO's FERC Electric Tariff No. 3, Sections 1 and 2.

Kleen is cooperating with emergency authorities at the site, and hopes to have further information for you without undue delay. Unfortunately, Kleen cannot presently estimate exactly when it will be able to make a more dispositive report. Emergency authorities have restricted access to the site, and the serious impact to workers at the site must be the foremost concern. We ask that you contact the undersigned with any

questions in the meantime, and would be grateful for your patience as Kleen works to assist affected workers and contractors and gather further information.
