

1. Manner in which intervenor's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings:

Intervenor's private residential property is on Ancient Highway in close proximity to the proposed tower site. Ancient Highway is a private, 0.4 mile road which Intervenor has deeded easement and property rights that may be violated through waivers sought in the petition. Utilities currently supporting the two residents on Ancient Highway were privately installed and owned by the respective estates. The intervenor associated with this request is an owner of these utilities. The petition does not describe processes for obtaining utilities from these privately owned power lines and poles. The 0.4 mile private portion of Ancient Highway is currently being maintained, including grading, gravel and winter plowing by the two residents on Ancient Highway and at the sole expense and labor of these two residents. If not consistently maintained, the private portion of Ancient Highway is impassable. The petition does not describe any reference to maintenance and upkeep of the private portion of the driveway, nor does the petition involve solutions in any way in efforts to proactively address an obvious entrance/egress issue for residents of Ancient Highway.

2. Manner and extent to which intervenor proposes to participate:

Intervenor proposes to participate in person at any hearings and be present at any site visits. Intervenor also wishes to speak on behalf of the only other resident using the road for daily entrance and egress, sharing in the responsibilities of maintaining the road and sharing in the costs of the private utilities. As appropriate Intervenor wishes to share easement, utility records and photos of the site not represented in the petition.

4. Nature of evidence intervenor intends to present:

Ancient Highway easement issued to Intervenor for access/egress and property rights
Utility company records identifying current utilities installed as privately owned by estate of 74 Ancient Highway.
Photographs not represented in the petition to more accurately inform council on site ecology, road limitations and residential nature of the area.
