RE: **PETITION NO. 1184** - Beacon Falls Energy Park, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed construction, operation, and maintenance of a 63.3 Megawatt AC fuel cell facility located on Lopus Road, Beacon Falls, Connecticut.

Dear Mr. Krenesky:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated November 4, 2015, concerning the above-referenced petition. Thank you for taking the time to provide the Council with your comments.

At a public meeting held on October 1, 2015, the Council considered and ruled to hold a public hearing on this matter. This schedule includes a public hearing in the Town of Beacon Falls on Thursday, November 5, 2015, at the Beacon Falls Fire House for the benefit of the public.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-40, a copy of the petition is to be submitted to the municipality where the facility is to be located for review. Before reaching a final decision on a petition, the Council carefully considers all of the facts contained in the evidentiary record that is developed by the Council, the petitioner, parties and intervenors in the proceeding and members of the public who speak at the public hearing or submit written statements to the Council.

In the event that you do not seek formal party or intervenor status under Connecticut General Statutes §16-50n, which provides full participation at the public hearing, including, but not limited to, cross examination of witnesses, parties and intervenors, your comments shall nevertheless become part of the official record in this proceeding in the form of a limited appearance defined under subsection (f) of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50n.

Therefore, copies of your correspondence will be distributed to all participants in the proceeding and will be administratively noticed in the record. Please note that you can view all of the documents related to this proceeding on our website at www.ct.gov/csc under the "Pending Proceedings" link. You may also keep apprised of Council events on the website calendar and agenda.



Ms. Bachman,

My name is Michael Krenesky and I am currently the Town Treasurer of the Town of Beacon Falls, and on Nov 16, 2015 I will be taking office as a member of the Board of Selectman. I would like to raise a question/concern related to the proposed fuel cell project. The concern is the location of the driveway access to the proposed property. The area of Lopus Road that is being suggested as the primary (only?) access to the property is on a very steep curve. In addition, Lopus Road may not be properly "banked" going around this corner and my concern is that placing the driveway in this location will create a hazard where a vehicle descending the hill will be drawn/pulled off the road into the driveway if the design and construction does not allow a proper apron area that would "push" the vehicle back in to the roadway.

I have no other comment at this time and based on the merits & documentation presented to date, I do not oppose the project. It is the access to the property that is in question. It is my intention to attend the 7:00PM Public Hearing on November 5, 2015.
